5-7 Winter Landscapes - Pencil/ Acrylic Paints

Students learn about basic landscape painting principles as they use acrylic paints to create their own winter scene.

8-10 Incomplete Abstract Day 1 - Pencil/ Acrylic Paints

Students learn about color mixing and composition as they extend the boundaries of an abstract image.

10-12 Incomplete Abstract Day 1 - Pencil/ Acrylic Paints

12 + Negative Space Drawing - Pencil/ Marker

Students learn about negative space as they use pencil and markers to represent a still life on paper.

5-7 Georgia O'Keeffe Painting - Watercolors/Pencil

Students will learn about color blending and wet on wet watercolor techniques as they create a painting of a flower.

8-10 Texture Drawing - Marker/ Pencils

Students will create different textures and will use them to add volume to various forms.

Students will learn how to use crosshatching to render three dimensional objects.
